### You CANNOT bring:

- Latex Paint\*
- Radioactives
- Explosives
- Biologicals
- Tires
- Automobile, Boat or ATV Batteries
- Medical Prescriptions or syringes
- Cylinders (propane)
- Ammunition
- Commercial Wastes
- Computer/Electronic Components

### **\*Latex paint will not be accepted at this collection event.**

Latex Paint is not a hazardous material. Follow the instructions below to properly dispose of latex paint.

- Open the can
- Let the paint dry out or solidify the paint with floor dry, cat litter, or sawdust.
- Dispose the can and solidified paint with your regular trash - please leave the lids off.

## BE CAREFUL!

These products have warning labels on them for a reason. Before putting them in your car, take the following precautions:

- \* Keep products in their original containers when possible.
- \* Make sure products are properly sealed to prevent leaks and spills.
- \* If a container is leaking, put it into a secondary leak-proof container.
- \* Do not mix products together.
- \* Dangerous reactions can occur when some chemicals are mixed.
- \* Pack containers in sturdy boxes in the trunk of your vehicle, away from the driver, passengers and pets.
- \* Cardboard boxes work well, but containers (other than gasoline cans) and boxes cannot be returned to you.
- \* Please do not put items in plastic bags.
- \* If a product does not have the original label, label it yourself if you are certain of the contents.
- \* This will help us dispose of it properly.
- \* Always store products in a secure place, away from children, pets, sparks and flames.
