## Would you like to know what's in your drinking water?



The Towns of Clay Banks, Forestville and Nasewaupee and the Village of Forestville are teaming up with the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point Center for Watershed Science and Education to offer its residents a chance to participate in a well water testing program.

- Residents who wish to participate must register in advance by June 30th by calling your respective Town (details on the following page).
- Participants will need to pick up their test bottle sometime during the week of July 13<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup> (details on times and locations on the following page). At that time, you can decide on your choice of test package and pay in advance.
- On Sunday, July 19<sup>th</sup>, participants will be required bring the sample to their respective Town drop-off site during the specified hours.
- Individual test results will first be mailed to you approximately 4 weeks after submitting your sample. You will also have an opportunity to attend an educational program scheduled for Monday, August 31<sup>st</sup> at the Forestville Town Hall in Maplewood. At that meeting University water quality specialists will discuss how to interpret results and talk about overall water quality in the Town of Forestville, Town of Nasewaupee and Village of Forestville.

The three test options available are:

- **Homeowners Package - \$49.** Includes tests for nitrate and coliform bacteria, the two most important tests to perform on a private well, as well as pH, alkalinity, hardness, conductivity, corrosivity and chloride.
- **Metals Package - \$45.** Tests for arsenic, lead, copper, iron, zinc, calcium, magnesium, manganese, sodium, potassium and sulfate
- **DACT Screen - \$27.** A screening tool for diaminochlorotriazine (DACT), which is a breakdown component of the commonly used corn herbicide atrazine.
- **Choose all 3 - \$113.** Includes all three of the test packages listed above. There is an \$8 discount for choosing to perform all three tests.

Interested residents should call their Town Representative below with questions regarding registration and/or testing bottle pick up/payment. All samples must be dropped off on Sunday, July 19th, and will then be transported to the Water and Environmental Analysis Lab at UW-Stevens Point by a Town representative.
