The Conditional Use Permit application, when filed with the Village clerk, will be presented to the Planning Commission for review at the scheduled meeting time of the third Monday of the month at 5:30p.m. at the Village Hall. All neighboring property owners, the community, and the Village Board may be present. The Planning Commission, after their meeting, will make their recommendation to the Village Board for their consideration (reference Village Ordinance Chapter 395).

Due date: Completed application, materials, and \$25 fee are due by the third Monday of the month so as to be available for the scheduled regular Planning Commission meeting which occurs the third Monday of every month. **Some examples of the need for a Conditional Use Permits are, but not limited to: raising chickens within the Village, running a home business, or having a swimming pool over 24" in depth on your property.**
